

Geography of Saku City

Saku City is located on the eastern edge of Nagano Prefecture, and is a highland city blessed with greenery and clear streams, located in the center of Saku Plain, one of the four plains that is sung about in the prefectual song, "Shinano no kuni"

The Chikuma River runs through the center of the city, with tributaries from the Namezu River, Katakai River, and Yukawa River flowing into it, and Saku carp, which grow in this abundant, clear water, is one of the city's most famous products. The vast fertile land that spreads across the city is said to be the breadbasket of Saku, and is used to cultivate rice, apples, peaches, prunes, highland vegetables, flowers, and more. Looking out in all directions, you can see Joshin'etsu Kogen National Park, centered around Mt. Asama, to the north, Yatsugatake Chushin Kogen Quasi-National Park to the south, and Myogi Arafune Saku Kogen Quasi-National Park to the east, with magnificent views. In autumn, cosmos flowers bloom beautifully in the refreshing natural surroundings, attracting many tourists.

The maximum daytime temperature in summer (August) can reach as high as 37.5°C on some hot days, but the daily average temperature is 25.8°C, and mornings and evenings are cool, making it a comfortable place to stay.

The central Saku City is located at an altitude of about 700 meters, and overlooking the Asama mountain range to the north, the Yatsugatake mountain range to the southwest, and Mount Arafune to the east. On clear, sunny days, you can even see the Northern Alps in the distance.

Saku City has little precipitation throughout the year, including snowfall in winter, and boasts one of the highest rates of sunny days in the country. Although the winters are harsh, with minimum temperatures sometimes dropping below -10°C, summer mornings and evenings are cool, and no tropical nights have been recorded since meteorological observations began.

These favorable weather conditions allow for the harvest of high-quality agricultural products such as rice and highland vegetables. Saku carp is made using the clear waters of the Chikuma River, and local sake and beer are brewed, providing delicious food for the dinner as a normal.

Additionally, no active faults have been confirmed in Saku City at present. The risk of earthquake disasters is low, making it a safe and secure place to live.

With the opening of Sakudaira Station on the Hokuriku Shinkansen in 1997, Saku City is now connected to Tokyo Station and Sakudaira Station in about 70 minutes. Improved access to the metropolitan area and urbanization due to development around Sakudaira Station have led to an increase in people commuting to work or school by Shinkansen and relocating to the area. Currently, the Hokuriku Shinkansen has been opened up to Tsuruga Station in Fukui Prefecture, and future extensions are expected to improve access to the Kinki region, including Osaka.

On the expressway, it takes about 100 minutes to get from Saku IC to Nerima IC. There are also express buses available. Furthermore, it is easy to access the Sea of Japan side (Joetsu City) via the Joshinetsu Expressway, and the Pacific side (Shizuoka City) via the Chubu-Odan Expressway. As the Chubu-Odan Expressway has an undeveloped section from the Yachiho-Kogen IC to the (tentative name) Nagasaka JCT on the Chuo Expressway, we are working to open the entire route as soon as possible.

The average life expectancy in Saku City in 2020 was about one year higher than the national average for both men and women. In particular, the average life expectancy for women was 12th in the nation, making it a city of healthy longevity.

Saku City has been a pioneer in preventive medicine and community medicine. It has close ties with citizens' "family doctors" close to home, specialized hospitals, and medical institutions with advanced medical treatment capabilities.

For primary emergency medical care, there are 84 clinics and 57 dental clinics located throughout the city, for secondary emergency medical care there are six specialized hospitals, including Asama General Hospital and Saku General Hospital, and for tertiary emergency medical care, the Saku Medical Center is responsible for specialized medical care and advanced medical care that specializes in emergency and acute care.

In cooperation with these medical institutions, the activities of public health nurses and health guidance officers who support local medical and welfare services help create a city where people can live long and healthy lives.



Saku City is a city blessed with a rich natural environment, good access to the metropolitan area, and a well-developed medical system. In addition, the city is seeing an increase in "educational migration" due to the spread of remote work and the continued opening of new, unique schools.

In response to the growing need for relocation, we have established subsidies for staying expenses for those considering relocating, subsidies for Shinkansen commuting for remote workers, and subsidies to support U-turn/I-turn/J-turn employment and start-up relocation

We are also working to increase the population through migration and revitalize the local area with migrants by developing co-working spaces to support remote work environments and carrying out projects that connect migrants with local companies through side jobs.

As a result of promoting these immigration policies, Saku City has seen more people moving out for 12 consecutive years, resulting in a consisitent net migration gain. In 2024, it recorded the highest net migration increase in the prefecture.

■ Children's SOS consultation form "TOUCH" operation project

This project utilizes the tablet devices provided to each elementary and junior high school student under the GIGA School Initiative to connect students to people they want to talk to about their problems. It helps students realize the benefits of connecting with the people around them and develops their ability to send out SOS messages themselves.


Asama Junior High School Expansion Project

The number of students at Asama Junior High School is on the rise, and there are concerns about a shortage of classrooms in the future. In light of this, we have been systematically renovating special classrooms and expanding regular classrooms, and we will continue to expand regular classrooms from last year, aiming to open them in 2026.

Main projects to be undertaken in FY2025

■Basic plan for redevelopment around Sakudaira Station

A quarter century has passed since the opening of Sakudaira Station, and the station square and Plaza Saku have issues such as aging facilities and lack of functionality compared to other Shinkansen stations. We will compile a basic plan for redevelopment to create a comfortable and convenient space as the gateway to Saku City for the next quarter century.

■ Social Capital Development Comprehensive Grant Road Project Shimohirao City Road 7-103 and Others A new sidewalk will be constructed and improved on the section of Prefectural Route Kusagoe-Hosho Saku Line from Ipponmatsu intersection towards Hiraoyama Park to Shibamiya Shrine intersection.

Due to the increase in vehicle traffic due to the opening of Hirao Mountain Hot Springs Miharashi no Yu, this route will connect with existing sidewalks and school routes to ensure the safety of pedestrians and others.

■ Regional public transportation system operation business

In order to realize optimal public transportation that reflects changes in social conditions and needs, such as the increase in the elderly population, we have begun full-scale operation of the "Demand Wagon Sakutto" from April 2023. We will continue to aim to realize smart public transportation that is easy to understand and use by reviewing bus stops and other measures to meet the needs of users.

■Multi-layered support system development project

In order to respond to the increasingly complex and multifaceted challenges facing our citizens, we will continue to build a comprehensive support system through multi-agency collaboration, while making use of existing consultation and support initiatives in areas such as nursing care, disabilities, children and child-rearing, and poverty.

■Third Saku City Health Promotion 21 Plan

Aiming to realize a society where every citizen can live a healthy and vibrant life, we have formulated a plan that takes into account changes in social life and the results and challenges of past efforts. From fiscal 2025 onwards, we will promote health promotion measures in line with this plan.

■Nozawa Children's Center/Childcare Support Center Facility Development Project

In addition to relocating and upgrading Nozawa Children's Center, which has been plagued by issues of deterioration and distance from the school, to a site adjacent to Nozawa Elementary School, we will also be developing a "children and child-rearing support center facility" that will provide specialized staff such as midwives and public health nurses to provide one-stop service for a variety of child-rearing inquiries and to provide a play area that will help develop children's various abilities.

- Saku City Regional Decarbonization Transition and Renewable Energy Promotion Grant Project In order to achieve carbon neutrality by 2050, we will work to reduce CO2 emissions by introducing self-consumption solar power generation equipment and LED lighting in public facilities and by providing subsidies to private businesses for the installation of solar power generation equipment.
- ■City Park Safety Renewal Project

Based on the Saku City Park Facility Longevity Plan, we are renovating and updating aging playground equipment in 55 urban parks in the city. In fiscal year 2025, we plan to renovate and update playground equipment in six parks, including the Citizen Exchange Park.

Main projects to be undertaken in FY2025

■ Promoting disaster prevention and mitigation projects to "build a disaster-resistant Saku City" [Agricultural facilities] In order to prevent damage to farmland and other areas caused by natural disasters, we will renovate agricultural facilities, etc., and work to prevent disasters from occurring and spreading.

[Roads] We will take measures to prevent disasters and maintain roads by strengthening road drainage functions and repairing pavements to prevent flooding.

[Rivers] We will work to prevent river flooding caused by heavy rain or flooding and flooding of houses, etc. by improving the river banks and line shapes of quasi-river and ordinary rivers.

■Disaster prevention administrative radio broadcast system equipment renewal project

In order to improve the functionality of disaster prevention administrative radio equipment, which transmits information quickly during emergencies such as disasters, we will be updating the equipment to one that can broadcast in easy-to-recognize voices according to the season, weather, etc.

Fire brigade facility equipment development project

In light of the increasing severity and frequency of various disasters in recent years, we will upgrade and deploy light-duty vehicles with small power pumps that can be deployed with a small number of people, in order to improve our response capabilities in the event of a disaster and our firefighting capabilities.



Main projects to be undertaken in FY2025

■Saku City 20th Anniversary Project

New Saku City, which was formed on April 1, 2005 through the merger of one city, two towns and one village, will celebrate its 20th anniversary on April 1, 2025. Commemorative events will be held from October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025, six months before and after April 1, 2025. Through these commemorative events, we will reaffirm the tangible and intangible assets that we have built together with our citizens, as well as promote the excellence of Saku City and foster civic pride.

■Saku City Urban Development Activity Support Fund Project

We aim to realize citizen-participation city administration by providing subsidies to public-interest projects that citizens undertake independently and proactively to address various issues facing the community, and by supporting citizens who will become the driving forces behind collaborative city development.

■Shinkansen Commuting Support Project for Remote Workers, etc.

By subsidizing part of the cost of purchasing Shinkansen tickets, etc., we will support remote workers who have relocated to our city to commute to the Tokyo area using the Hokuriku Shinkansen departing from Sakudaira Station. We will further promote relocation by raising the age requirement for subsidy recipients to under 50 years old from fiscal year 2025.


